Penfield Montessori provides a child-centered, personalized approach to learning. Our integrated classrooms include holistic programming, emphasizing peace education, a love of nature, social-emotional learning and early literacy. Each child is celebrated for his/her abilities, diversity and personal interests.

Early Literacy: PMA utilizes two approaches based in neuroscience-the Orton Gillingham (OG) approach and Language Acquisition through Motor Planning (LAMP) to teach literacy. OG is a direct, explicit, multisensory, structured, sequential, diagnostic, and prescriptive way to teach literacy when reading, writing, and spelling does not come easily to individuals. LAMP uses motor learning approaches and voice output to promote communication.

Technology integration: Utilization of Augmentive and Alternative Communication (AAC) devices

Arts and Music: Partnerships with Music and Art Therapy institutions provide all students with opportunities to explore the fine arts.

Social emotional learning: On-site school counselor, partnership with Penfield's Behavior Clinic for in-home counseling and teachers trained in the ARC (Attachment, Regulation and Competency) Framework.

2018-19 HIGHLIGHTS

- -From the 2017/2018 to 2018/2019 school years, the number of students who met their academic goals on the MAP assessment increased by 25% for math and 11% for reading.
- -The Milwaukee Fire Department's Warm Up Winter campaign provided a new winter coat to every child at Penfield Montessori.
- -Hosted the Montessori Inclusion Conference in collaboration with the Theodor Hellbrüegge Foundation and sponsored by Montessori Medical Partnership for Inclusion.
